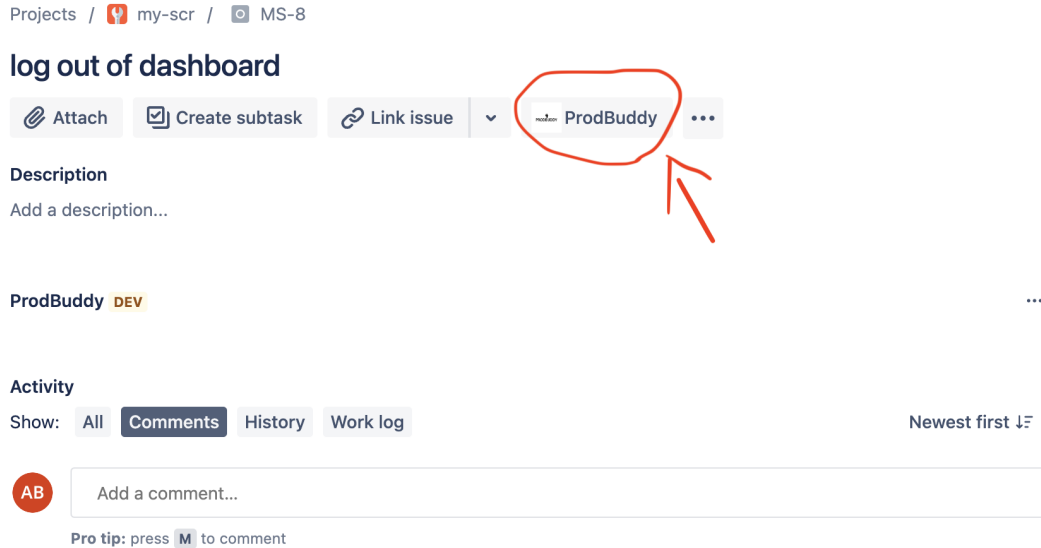
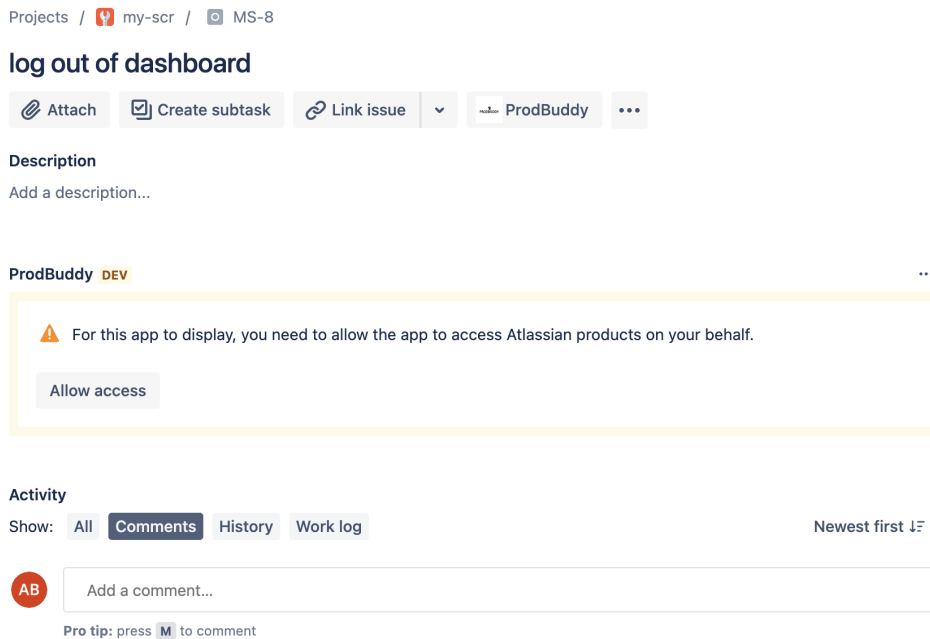


# ProdBuddy Documentation

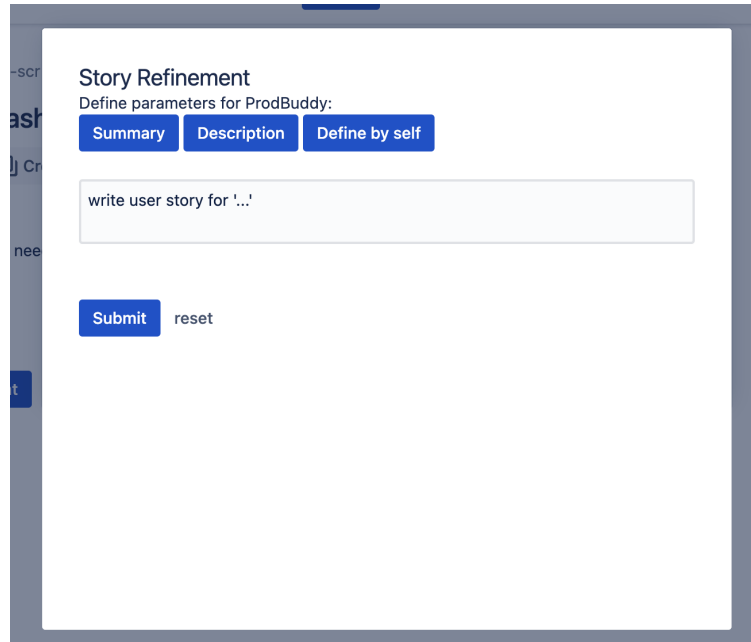

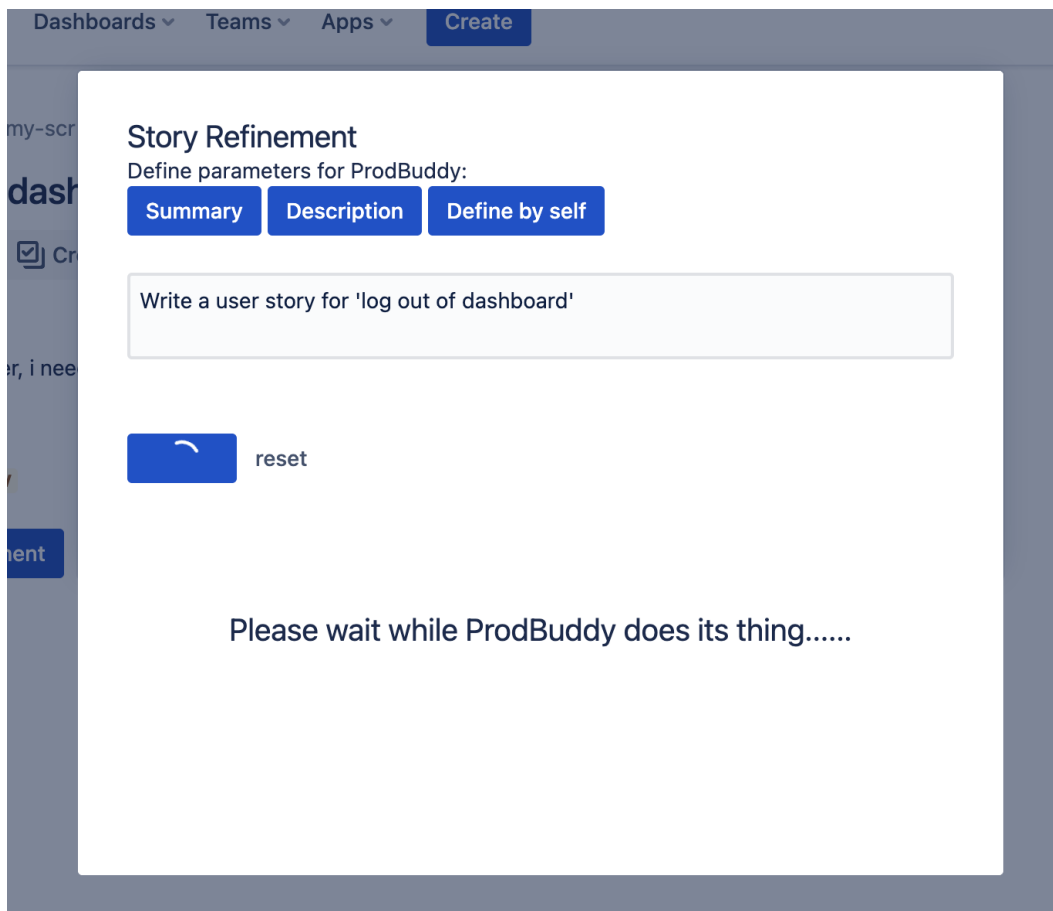

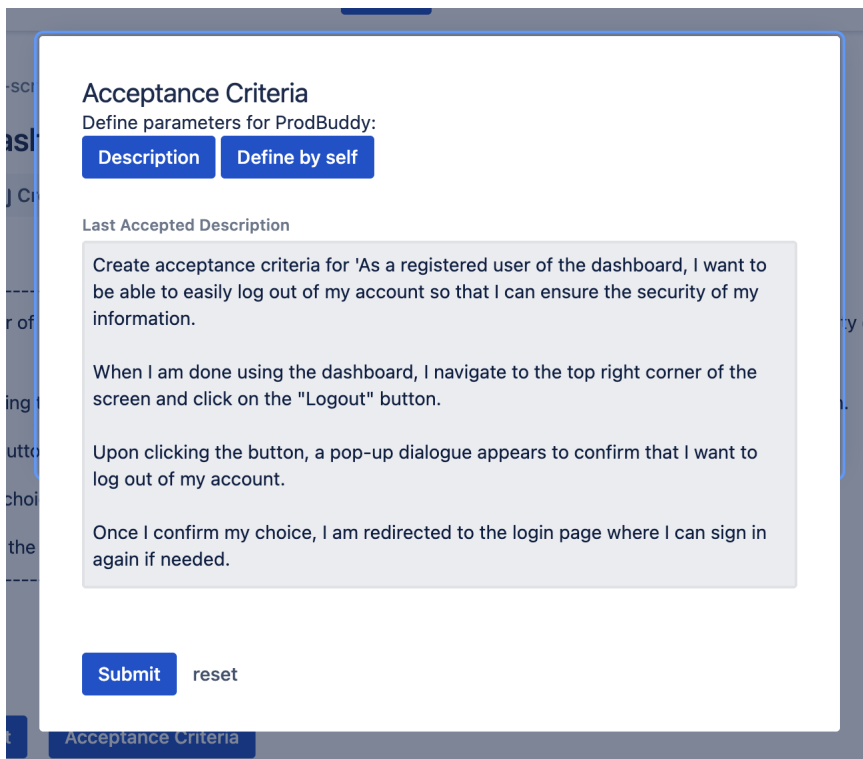

- The "Logout" button is easily visible and accessible on the top right corner of the screen.
- Clicking on the "Logout" button triggers a pop-up dialogue to confirm that the user wants to log out.
- The pop-up dialogue clearly states that logging out will end the current session and the user will need to sign in again to access the dashboard.
- The pop-up dialogue includes a "Confirm" and "Cancel" button, and clicking on "Confirm" logs the user out of their account.
- After logging out, the user is redirected to the login page.
- The login page is secure and does not reveal any information from the previous session.
- After logging out, the user is no longer able to access their dashboard until they sign in again.
- Logging out does not affect any saved preferences or settings for the user's account.
